Evening at Emory Instructor Publishes Part II of the Julius Thompson Trilogy

ATLANTA, Ga. – Aug 3 – Julius Thompson, Evening at Emory instructor and published novelist, is pleased to announce the release of *Philly Style and Philly Profile*, Part II in the Julius Thompson Trilogy. Thompson will debut the novel in Philadelphia on September 13th and will be teaching Creative Writing and Publishing Parts I&II for Evening at Emory this fall.

The Julius Thompson Trilogy follows main character Andy Michael Pilgrim's thirty year odyssey from Brooklyn through Philadelphia to Atlanta, and chronicles the life-altering situations he faces. In *Philly Style and Philly Profile*, the follow-up to *A Brownstone in Brooklyn* published by Seaburn Publishing, Pilgrim moves from Brooklyn to Philadelphia in the seventies where he works as a sportswriter, watching the influences of drugs and gangs destroy young people's lives.

After working as a copy boy with the New York Times, and a sportswriter with the Philadelphia Bulletin, Thompson became a published novelist. He won the Associated Press Sports Editors Award in 1977 at the Philadelphia Bulletin for the third best sports story written that year. Currently, Thompson shares his passion for literature with the youth as a Language Arts teacher in the Dekalb County Public School System, and enjoys the opportunity to share his passion with adult students through Evening at Emory.
